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Housing Trust Fund Act:

A. "affordable housing" means residential housing
primarily for persons or households of low or moderate income;

B. "authority" means the New Mexico mortgage finance authority;

C. "committee" means the New Mexico housing trust fund advisory committee;

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D. "fund" means the New Mexico housing trust fund;

"persons of low or moderate income" means persons and households within the state who are determined by 10 the authority to lack sufficient income to pay enough to cause 11 12 private enterprise to build and preserve an adequate supply of decent, safe and sanitary residential housing in their locality 13 14 or in an area reasonably accessible to their locality and whose incomes are below the income levels established by the 15 authority to be in need of the assistance made available by the 16 New Mexico Housing Trust Fund Act, taking into consideration, 17 without limitation, such factors as defined under that act; and 18

The "New Mexico housing trust fund advisory 7 committee" is created. The committee shall consist of the 8 following nine members, who shall represent geographically the 9 state, affordable housing advocates and practitioners: 10 three public members appointed by the (1) 11 governor; 12 (2) three public members appointed by the 13 president pro tempore of the senate; and 14 (3) three public members appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives. 15 Members of the committee shall be appointed for 16 Β. 17 two-year terms and shall be eligible for reappointment.
